## Interesting fact 1

Portugal is one of the world's top **surf** spots. Portugal has a coastline that spans 800 kilometres and it's known to have 364 days of surf. In 2011, this fact was taken advantage of at Praia de Norte, a beach near the town of Nazaré. It was here that Hawaiian Garret McNamara broke records by surfing the biggest waver ever caught, which was an astonishing 90 ft. high. That's nearly 27.5 meters.

## Interesting fact 2

Portugal was the first colonial power to abolish slavery. It abolished slavery all the way back in 1761 - that's half a century before Britain, France, Spain, or the United States.

## Exchange rates

The exchange rate is one euro equals \$1.40 in Australia. One euro equals 84p in England.

So, if a kinder surprise costs \$2.13 in Australia and £1.28 in England, it would cost €1.51 in Portugal.
